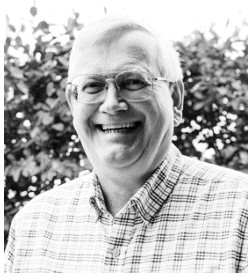
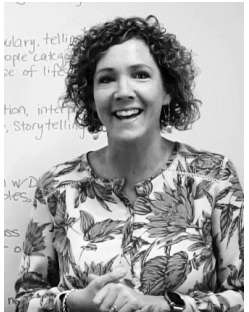


RCA STAFF, ECUMENICAL GUESTS AND WORKSHOP LEADERS

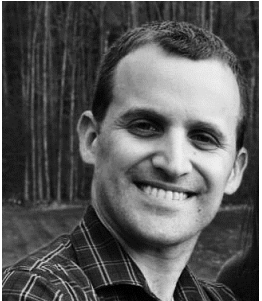
